

Children may match the quarter turn and the three-quarter turn the other way around, as a quarter turn one way can also be a three-quarter turn the other way.

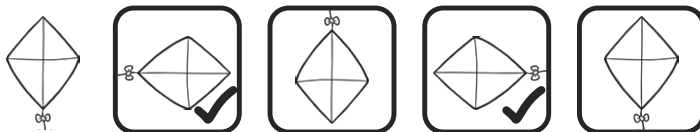
Either of these answers are correct:

The tile made a quarter turn.

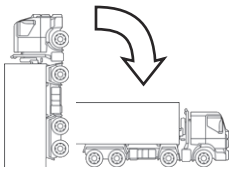
The tile made a three-quarter turn.

The rocket tile could make a half turn in either direction.

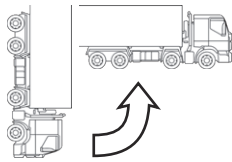
No, the boat tile would need to make half a turn in either direction to face the boy.



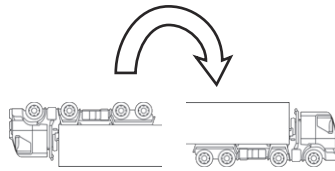
