It has been really lovely to see the whole class as one, instead of two different groups. The children have been getting on well and have made some new friends within the class. ## Home Learning

Please practise dressing and undressing at home. This includes the children getting themselves dressed for school, doing up buttons on their polo shirt or cardigan, put their shoes (and having them on the right feet) and putting their coat on and fastening the zips, poppers etc. By the end of Reception the children should be able to do this independently and competently.
