We have had a lovely week in Acorn class. In Phonics, we have learnt the letter names and sound for s and a. S as in the word sun and a as in the word ant. We then sorted objects and pictures based on the first sound we could hear in the word.



In Maths, we have been looking at big and smaller. We found objects around the classroom and talked about whether they were bigger or smaller than another object. We had a picnic for Bertie the big bear and Betty the little bear, we had to give them the correct item (plate, cup, chocolate, crisps) based on whether it was big or small. We also looked at some balance scales and learnt how to tell which side was heavier and which side was lighter. We then learnt how to make sure both sides were the same. Once we had learnt how to make the sides the same, we made cakes. We had to balance each of

the ingredients with the egg and then mixed up them all together and put them into cases. Miss Traviss cooked them for us, ready to take home and eat.
