In Phonics, we have learnt the letter names and sound for t and p, t as in the word tap and p as in the word pig. We have spent time identifying the letter shapes and practising our segmenting and blending. We had a go at reading some simple words!

In Maths, we have been looking at patterns. We have identified what a pattern is, a repeated design, and found patterns on animals and around the room. We then created our own pattern using objects, it really helped us to say our pattern out loud. For example, Miss Traviss used yellow and green counters for her pattern and we chanted yellow, green, yellow, green, yellow, green to remind us what came next.

In RE, Miss Traviss brought in her precious pearl bracelets for us to look at. We then read the story 'The Precious Pearl' about a man who had everything he wanted and then one day saw a precious pearl in a shop, he wanted to buy it but he had to sell all of his stuff, including his house. We learnt that it feels really nice to have something so special and this is how Christians feel about God.

We learnt about bonfire night about how it is celebrated. We watched some fireworks (on the computer) and made our own firework pictures.
