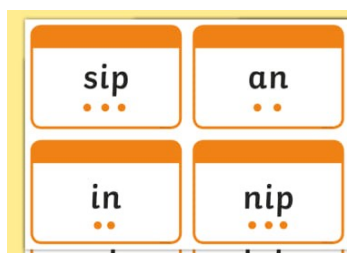


Acorn News...

In Phonics, we have learnt the letter names and sound for i (as in ink), n (as in net), m (as in Mum) and d (as in Dad). We have been practising reading simple words by pressing sound buttons and saying the sounds and then saying them really quickly again so we can hear the words. We have continued to identify objects and pictures by the first sound and recognising the letter shapes that match each sound.

In Maths, we have been looking at the numbers 1 and 2. We have looked at the numeral, the dots on a dice, the numicon piece and we have been counting objects and things that cannot be counted physically like claps.

In RE, we have been talking about all the animals in the world that Christians believe God made. We talked about why it is important to look after them all, including the little minibeasts that we may not like.

We learnt about Remembrance Day and why people wear poppies. We watched a short video about a rabbit who gets scared of loud noises along with all his other animal friends, he hides and then one day it is all calm again and beautiful poppies begin to grow. We joined the rest of the school for a two minute silence on the playground.
