In Phonics, we have been recapping the sounds we have learnt so far. We have learnt the tricky word 'to'. A tricky word is one that can not be read using our phonics sounds, we have to learn the word by sight. We have continued reading short words using sound buttons. In Maths, we have been looking at the number 3 and then comparing the numbers 1 2 3. We have been looking at how many dots there are for 1 2 3 and seeing which has the most and which has the least. We have been counting forward and backwards and showing this using counters, each time we say a number to add or remove a counter.

In RE, we discussed why God put humans in the world, to look after it. We talked about ways we could look after the world and read the story, 'The Messy Magpie' who was collecting everyone's rubbish and then realised it was a bad thing to do. Then, we went onto the playground and collected rubbish to show God we were looking after the world.

Mrs Delaney visited our class to talk about the celebration 'Diwali' we learnt that people decorate their houses with lots of lights, buy new clothes and have lots of yummy food to eat. We have made our own diva lamps, tried some indian sweets and made 'happy Diwali' cards. It has been lots of fun learning about a new celebration and we began to compare it to Christmas.
