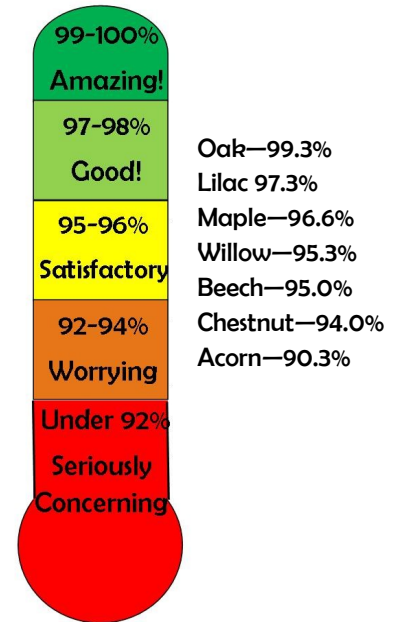
Yesterday we had our Christmas Lunch and today we had our Christmas Mass.

Attendance

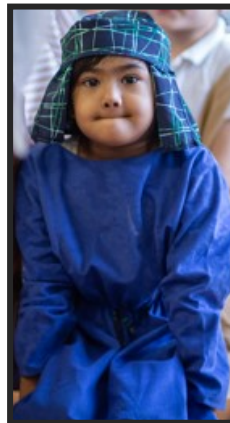
Well done to all those children who achieved 100% attendance this term. As a whole school we have an attendance target of 97% to achieve.
