If items are NOT NAMED we cannot guarantee they will be returned to the correct person when lost!

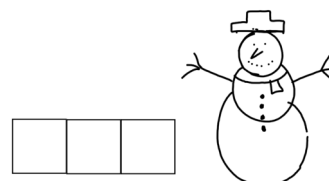
Sports Day

Home Learning

In class we have been playing the game 'snowman', this is similar to hangman but a snowman is drawn. The children have really enjoyed guess the sounds that might be in the word the adults have thought of.

We would like you to play this with your child at home to practise their spelling and word pattern recognition skills.



This week...

We have had a great week in Acorn class. In phonics, we have been doing our phonics assessments. Miss Traviss spends some time with each child to see what sounds and words they know and whether they can apply them in their reading.

In maths, we have been looking at number stories using 'first then now' to understand addition. For example, first there are three dinosaurs, then two more want to join, now we have five dinosaurs altogether. The children have had a go at drawing their own and we have used 10s frames and counters to demonstrate our understanding.

In RE, we reminded ourselves of the story of Joseph and his colourful coat. He was able to read peoples dreams, some said he had the 'gift of reading dreams'. We discussed a gift being something you are good at so we all thought of something we were good at.

The whole class are the stars of the week as everyone in the class did a fantastic job of participating during sports day. Thank you to Mr Luckhurst for organising it for us!
