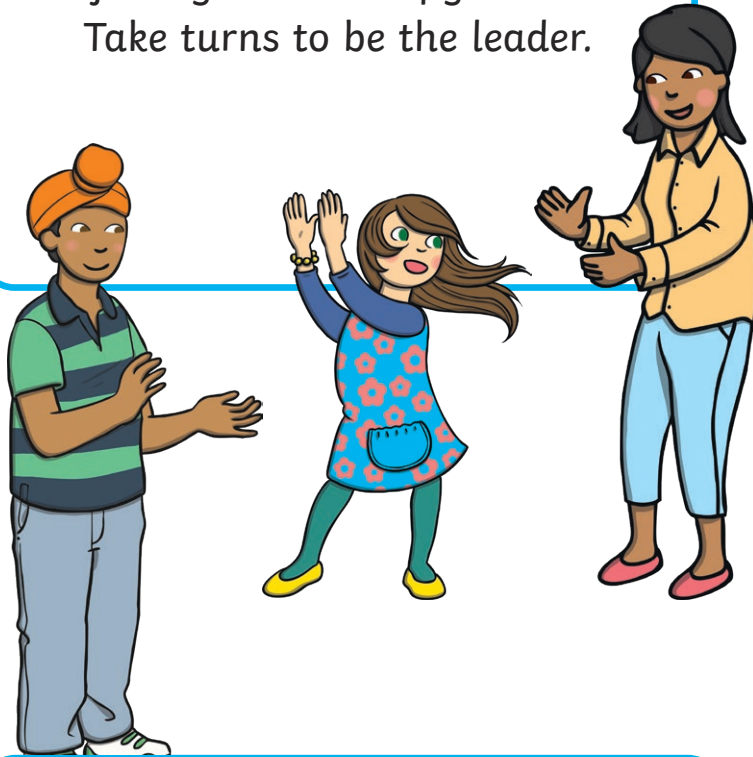


General Sound Discrimination

Home Learning Challenges
