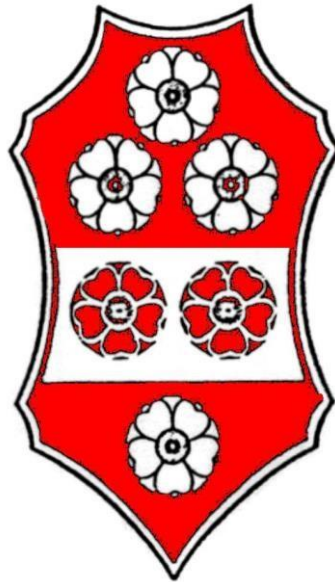

Behaviour Principles Written Statement Section 88

Governors Statement of General Principles of behaviour and discipline for St Barnabas' CE (VA) Primary School to which the head teacher is to have regard in determining any measures under section 89 (1)

- (a) Promote, among pupils, self-discipline and proper regard for authority.
- (b) Encourage good behaviour and respect for others on the part of pupils and, in particular, preventing all forms of bullying among pupils,
- (c) Secure that the standard of behaviour of pupils is acceptable, (as determined by the head teacher).
- (d) Secure that pupils complete any tasks reasonably assigned to them in connection with their education, and
- (e) Otherwise regulate the conduct of pupils in line with the school's Christian ethos and statutory regulations.

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
