Secondary School Transfer - September 2018

Kent's Secondary Transfer Scheme 2018 has now been determined and the arrangements for the Kent Grammar School Testing are as follows:

Registration opens: 1 June 2017

Registration closes: 3 July 2017

Test for children in Kent Primary Schools: 7 September 2017

Assessment decision letter sent to parents: 12 October 2017 to arrive on 13 October 2017

Parents of children in Year 5 will be able to register for the Kent Test (11+) online via www.kent.gov.uk/ola.

If you register online and provide an email address, you will receive your child's assessment decision after 4pm via email on 12th October 2017. This is a day earlier than the posted decision letters. Applying online also means that it is quicker and easier to apply for secondary schools as you can use the same log-in details.
