
ACOPIN Rew Friday 27th November 2020



In Phonics, we have learnt the sounds g o c and k.

We have learnt the tricky word 'the'. We have
been reading short captions using the word the and have began to segment simple words to help us with our spelling. We

have used a phoneme frame to introduce this. When using a phoneme frame we need to write one sound in each box.

In Maths, we have been comparing amounts of more/less and at basic addition of numbers up to 3, we have used our numicon shapes to show which numbers can be put together to make other numbers and have shared animals into 2 fields to show how addition can be made up of 2 groups.

In RE, we have discussed Jesus being the son of God and how we were all babies once. We were shown pictures of Miss Traviss, Miss Burkinshaw and Mrs Allee as babies and we didn't believe the adults were once babies!

We have been practising our nativity song lots and have now added actions! We read the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and acted it out. We all got to be different parts of the story, some of us were characters and others were objects. This is in preparation for starting our helicopter story scribing activity after Christmas.
