Christmas is in full swing in Acorn class, we have decorated our classroom with a Christmas tree, lights and tinsel! We also have a class advent calendar where we need to open one stocking in day to find a little treat.

In Phonics, we have learnt the sounds ck e and u. We have learnt the tricky word 'I'. We have been writing words containing these sounds and finding the sounds within words. We have started to do smaller phonics groups after our input so we get some really focussed learning at our level with Miss Traviss.

In Maths, we have been looking at the shapes, circle and triangle. We have been describing these shapes and talking about the number of sides and corners. A circle has one curved side and no corners and a triangle has 3 straight sides and 3 corners. We found these shapes around the classroom and have learnt they are 2D shapes so we can't pick the shape up but we can pick the object up and see the shape. We have also been looking at positional language e.g. next to, behind, under, in front of.

In RE, we introduced the Christmas story and found out some of the characters. We learnt that Jesus was the most important person in the story.

We have filmed our nativity song this week and all looked fantastic in our angel cos-

tumes, we can't wait to watch it! Also, we have been using our sounds to write our letters to Santa, ready to post next week.
