I try to pray every day because I know God likes to hear me talk to him. I know God hears my prayers and this brings me comfort when I ask for help or guidance.

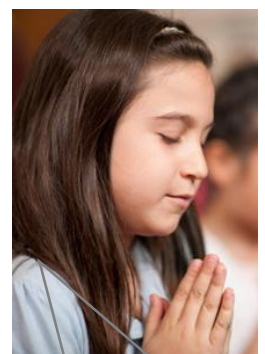
Prayer is part of my everyday life. It is like breathing for me as I can't live without it. Prayer helps me to get to know God better every day.

I like to pray by myself when I am outside. I spend more time being quiet and listening to God. Spending time with God each day helps me to stay close to God.



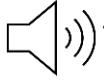
I pray a lot, at church, with my family and on my own. I praise God, say sorry, ask for help and say thank you. I try to follow the example of Jesus when I pray.
