We have been doing lots of learning about 'The Easter Story' this week. We read the story and found out why and how Jesus died. We then got the chance to try hot cross buns, a food traditionally eaten at Easter time. We found out that hot cross buns remind Christians of Jesus dying on the cross. We also looked at our Easter garden and discussed which parts reminded us of how Jesus died. We also found out that if you turn a cross on its side it looks like a kiss, this reminds us that Jesus loved us. We talked about eggs being around and eggs being a symbol of new life. We then had an Easter egg hunt!

In Phonics we have recapped the sounds j and v. We have also been writing words containing the sounds we have learnt.

In Maths, we have been learning about height and length. We used the language of taller, longer and shorter. We had to make towers taller or shorter than Miss Traviss'. We also use non standard measurements like cubes, blocks, lego and duplo to measure how taller an item is.

We were very lucky to have Simon and Paul from Drama Geezers support us to write a whole school story. They were lots of fun and the children were brilliant actors!
