The children have come back really positive and ready to learn which is brilliant!

In Phonics, we have been recapping v, x, w and y and we have learnt the tricky word 'we'. We have been practising writing these sounds and we have seen a great improvement with the children's cursive writing and their perseverance with writing letters. In our Phonics focus groups we have been writing short sentences and words and playing orally blending bingo.

In Maths, we have looked at time. We used different types of timers to see how quickly we could line up and tidy up the class. Miss Traviss and Miss Burkinshaw had a competition to see who could write the word cat the most number of times before the timer ran out. We also read the story, Jasper's Beanstalk. He plants a seed and has to wait a long time until it grew. We had the opportunity to plant our own seeds—tomatoes, sunflowers or beans. We then ordered the pictures to show what we had done and what will happen next. We have also practised our days of the week song and ordering the days of the week. Well done to our star of the week, Nikola, she is a fantastic role model to her friends and is always demonstrating our

This week, we have introduced a new reward system. The children each have a virtual monster and have the opportunity to gain (or loose) points. Snack
