Lots of parents get a bit fed up of children saying 'I'm BORED!' Imagine one day you came home from school and your mum or dad were there saying 'I'm BORED!'

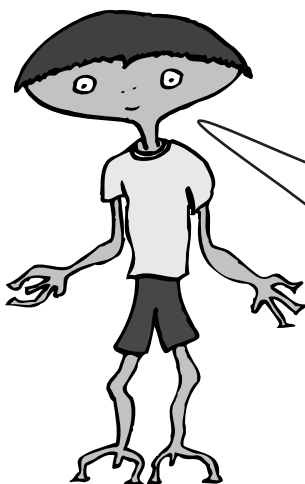
1. What would you say to them?
