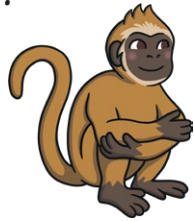
## The /ee/ Sound Family

**ey**

**ey** is sometimes used when the /ee/ sound is at the end of a word.

**y** saying /ee/ is used more often than **ey**.

**monkey**  
**honey**  
**chimney**



**ea**

**ea** is sometimes used when the /ee/ sound is in the middle of a word.

**steam**  
**beach**  
**treat**



**ie**

Sometimes, when **ie** appears in the middle of a word, it makes an /ee/ sound.

**chief**  
**field**  
**shriek**



**e**

At the end of some short words **e** makes an /ee/ sound.

**she**  
**be**  
**me**



**ee**

**ee** is often used in the middle or at the end of words.

**see**  
**peeler**



**e\_e**

The split digraph **e\_e** is often used when the /ee/ sound is in the middle of the word. It can be used at the start of some words.

**complete**  
**theme**  
**Eve**



**y**

When **y** appears at the end of a word, it usually makes an /ee/ sound.

happy  
jolly



**y** is used more often than **ey** at the end of words.
