We will be going on a walk to the park the our year 6 buddies on Wednesday 3rd November at 9am. We will need 4 parent helpers for us to enable this trip to happen.

It has been a busy week in Acorn class and we have been doing lots of new learning! In Phonics, we have learnt the letter sounds, s as in sun, a as in apple and

t as in table. We have been writing these sounds and deciding which pictures and objects have these sounds at the beginning of the words. In Maths, read 'The Button Box' and have been comparing buttons to see which have properties that are the same and which are different. We have also been looking at AB patterns (using two mediums e.g. colours, objects), Miss Traviss created some patterns for us to guess the two mediums and she then made some for us to have a go at continuing making our own patterns.

In RE, we have being learning that the word 'God' is a very special name and should be used with care. We read the story 'The Precious Pearl' and found out that the merchant would give anything to have the precious pearl and this is how Christians feel about God's love. We had a visit from a firefighter called Vernon who told us how important his job is to help keep us safe, he taught us the special number we need to ring if we need help and its an emergency and he explained how important it is not to play with fire! We also met our year 6 buddies and had time to play with them. Our buddies with help us during our first year of school at lunchtimes, with reading and going on trips.
