## School verbs

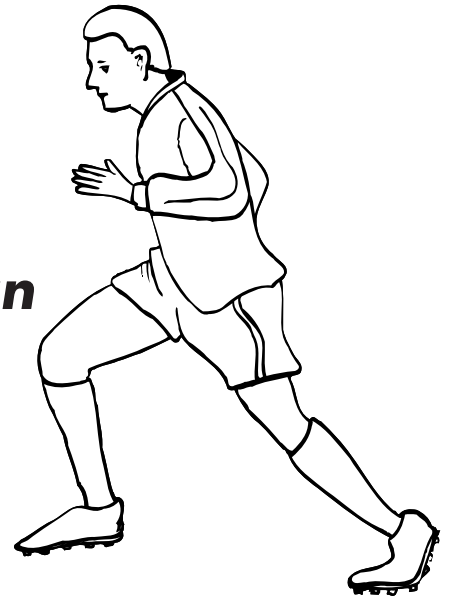
Your child is learning about verbs at school this term. Knowing the function of each word in a sentence (grammar) helps to build your child's understanding of how language works. A good way to identify a verb is that it can have 'I', 'we', 'you', 'he', 'she' or 'they' in front of it and make sense. E.g. I talk, he runs, we eat...

6. Put a small smiley face beside each of these.



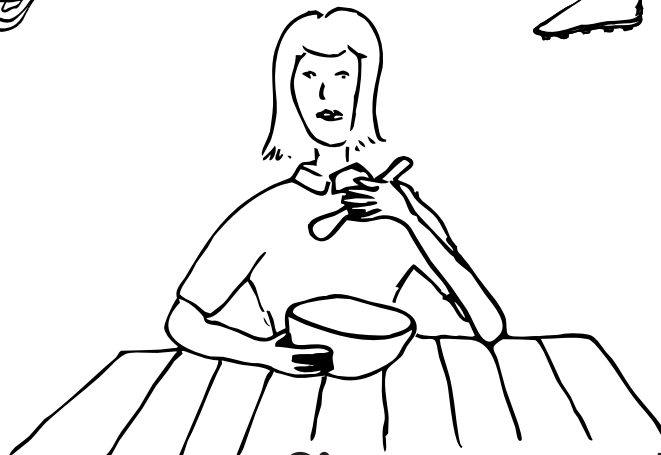
