Question	Answer
1	two different squares drawn on the grid
2	three different rectangles drawn on the grid
3	three different triangles (three straight sides) drawn on the grid
4	three different hexagons (six straight sides) drawn on the grid
5	Children are unlikely to have drawn the same shapes. They can check that their partner's shapes have the correct numbers of sides.
6	pentagon drawn on the grid There are multiple possible answers: any shape with five straight sides.
7	multiple possible answers, e.g. a square, a pentagon It cannot be a triangle, because a triangle only has three sides and Ben's shape must have at least four sides.
8	No The sides are not straight.
9	multiple possible answers, e.g.  Children need to check that the shapes in their instructions will all fit on the grid.
