
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Our phonics scheme at St Barnabas is Twinkl Phonics. This week we have learnt two trigraphs (three letters that make one sound) 'air' and 'ure'. We have spent two days on each sound, one with a reading focus and one with a writing focus. We have lots of sounds now and so this is enabling us to write bigger words and longer phrases.


