Home Learning

Over the next few weeks we will be looking at ourselves and our families. We will be talking about how they are the same and how they are different. We will also be looking at how much we have grown since we were babies. Please could you send in or email two photos—one of your child as a baby and one of your child with their family. Please share these photos with your child and begin to talk about changes from a baby to a child and also ensure they know the people in their family photo.

In Phonics this week we have been playing listening games. We have been listening for initial sounds and blending cvc words that have been segmented. In Maths we have been playing matching games like snap and pairing socks. We were given pictures of objects to find around the classroom. We have also been talking about 'sets' and having to find the same set as a grown up. We have started thinking about ourselves, our families and how we are different. We have been drawing photos of ourselves and are practising our name writing skills too.
