#### Our learning this week...

In Phonics we have learnt the sounds ff (as in off) and ss (as in kiss). These sounds are both digraphs as there are two letters making one sound. On Monday we will learn the final sound of level 2 (s as in pigs—this is making a zzz sound) and we have learnt all of the level 2 tricky words. Children will now start to bring reading books home with all the sounds and words that we have learnt so far. This means that reading books will also start to have more words in each sentence.

In RE, we have continued to look at the nativity story. We retold the story in our own words and read a different version to the one we read last week. We also decided who was the most important character in the story, we decided it was Jesus then the Angel Gabriel and Mary.

We FINALLY got to perform our nativity on stage in our costumes to our parents and carers. All of the children did a fantastic job and well done to Beech class for the voice overs and puppets. We have spent a long time practising the songs and we are very proud of the children. We hope you enjoyed it too!

We have enjoyed lots of singing and dancing in class this week along with wrapping up 'presents' for our friends and family. We have been busy making salt dough decorations and orange slice foxes to sell at the festive fair. The festive fair will raise much needed funds for the school so please join us in the hall for the festivities.

This week, we also enjoyed our Christmas lunch in the hall with year 1. We hope you all have a very merry Christmas and a break over the next few weeks and looking forward to seeing everyone in January!





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Our phonics scheme at St Barnabas is Twinkl Phonics. Here is some information about the sounds and words we have learnt this week that may support your child's learning at home.
















# Word List Help your child to sound out and blend to read these words. Less boss hiss fuss mess kiss
