Our learning this week...

In Phonics we have been recapping the level 2 sounds and words that we have learnt. Miss Burkinshaw has been undertaking phonics assessments to ensure we can plan children's next steps accurately. We have also been practising writing all of the sounds and the children are becoming really confident with this. We will be start level 3 sounds and words from next week.

In Maths, we learnt a new song '5 little peas in a pea pod press', we used our fingers to act out the song. We then had to use a template of a hand to find 5 objects (1 for each finger). We were then introduced to a die pattern for the number 5 and checked that five objects was still the same whether it was on our finger template or the die pattern.

We have attended whole school act of worship this week and will continue to go twice a week. The children sat beautifully and listened to what the adults leading it had to say.

In RE, we recapped our learning about the importance of Christmas to Christians and the key characters and events that happened. We also shared our own Christmas experiences.

In Drawing Club, we have been reading 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. The children really enjoyed watching the animated version of the story before Christmas. We have drawn the tiger, the café and a 'tiger bus' to take the tiger home. The children are beginning to develop their own ideas further which is lovely to see. They have also been challenged this week to write some words (or the sounds they can hear in words) that link to their pictures.
