# Getting Dressed!

We have limited time for changing so it really helps everyone if your child can change themselves independently. Please support us in allowing your child to practise getting themselves dressed and undressed for school independently.

#### Our learning this week...

In Phonics, we have recapped the sounds qu (as in queen) and ch (as in chick). We have also learnt the tricky word, we and me. We have been practising reading and writing words with these sounds in. For our tricky word we practised reading sentences and thinking of our own sentences using the word. Some children have been writing sentences using our tricky words! Please remember to practise tricky words at home too!

In Maths, we have been looking at counting, ordinality and cardinality. We have learnt the song 1 2 3 4 5 once I caught a fish alive. We made sure we put one finger up for each number we said until we got to 10. We used flashcards with the numeral on and had to show an equal number of fingers to what was on the flashcard. We learnt that equal means 'the same'. We also counted objects and actions remembering to stop at the number that was on the flashcard. Miss Traviss missed our Tuesday Maths lesson and didn't realise she had to stop counting when she got to the number on the flashcard, we had to teach her how to count!

We have started challenges in our own learning time this week. For each challenge we complete we get a sticker on the chart, if we complete all three challenges we will get a prize from the prize box. This week's challenges were draw your house, build a house and draw a local 'landmark'. We looked at these 'landmarks' to see if the children had been to them before or knew what they were. The 'landmarks' included the Church, the fire station, the cinema, the park, the doctors, the shopping centre and the children's favourite — McDonalds!

We have had two exciting visitors come and see us this week. The company PERFORM sent us a cowboy and a horse with a golden mane to do a drama workshop with us. We also met Phil from Jaws 'n' Claws who bought in some unusual animals for us to see and share some exciting facts about them.
