We have had a great week back in Acorn Class, it's nice to see everyone so refreshed.

In phonics, we have learnt the sounds i (as in insect), n (as in nut), m (as in meatball) and d (as in drum). We have continued to practise our oral segmenting and blending and have begun to read simple words using our sounds.

In maths, we have continued our learning with the numbers 1, 2 and 3. We have been practise our subitising, this is recognising the number of things without counting them. We have also been counting and ensuring we know that the last number we say is the amount we have altogether. We have explored the concept that numbers are made up from smaller numbers and demonstrated this using numicon.

We really enjoyed our walk to the park with our buddies. The children were excellently behaved and listened to the adults who were supporting them. Thank you to the parents who helped us on the trip. The children have been printing pumpkins using apples and making faces in the top. We have been scooping the insides of the pumpkins out and talking about how the insides feel.

This week, we have introduced 'star of the week'. This is someone the adults in the class feel has made a huge effort or exceptional progress in their learning. The star of the week gets a special treat of bringing Wilfred the Elephant home with them over the following week. Information about how to care for Wilfred is in the book. This weeks 'star of the week' is, Robert for feeling more confident in asking the adults for help.


Khloe enjoyed scooping our the pumpkin.



Jasper found number 3... twice!




Juno made a total of 22 biscuits using the playdough.





Robert found that 2 and 1 make 3.














Our phonics scheme at St Barnabas is Twinkl Phonics. Here is some information about the sounds we have learnt this week that may support your child's learning at home.











